The information below will help you to find your way around easier.

TRANSPORTATION FROM THE AIRPORT TO DOWNTOWN

Transportation from the airport is highly efficient via the S-Bahn (speed train) that leaves every 10 minutes. Depending on the location of your hotel, the best exit is the Central Station. A one-day ticket (all zones) costs €9,00. Don't forget, you will need to purchase a ticket back to the airport.

TRANSPORTATION FROM DOWNTOWN TO THE CONVENTION CENTRE

The International Convention Center Munich (ICM) is located just outside Munich and can be reached best by Underground. In order to travel to the ICM for the first time, you need to buy your own ticket. However, the registration package that you will receive at the ICM will include a **transportation pass** valid for the remainder of the week.

Ticket vending machines are available at all Underground stations. You need to push the red button "1" and pay €2.20 for your one-way ticket. It is important to validate the ticket in the "blue boxes" before entering the Underground.

The Underground exit at the ICM is called Messegeleände West. Signage will guide you to the ICM.
